During the workshop taking place in the conference room on the ground floor of the facility, the fire alarm system is activated. Staff confirms a fire in the first floor exhibition room. The evacuation of people gathered in the facility begins, several employees tried to extinguish the fire, but unfortunately it was unsuccessful. The fire cuts off their only possible exit, they get out to the balcony where they wait for help. The alerted forces and resources of the State Fire Service arrive at the site.

Action taken:

- identification, contact and cooperation with the facility manager;
- firefighting activities inside the facility;
- evacuation of people from the balcony using a mechanical ladder;
- evacuation of collections from the facility to a specialized container of the State Fire Service Officers School in Krakow.
